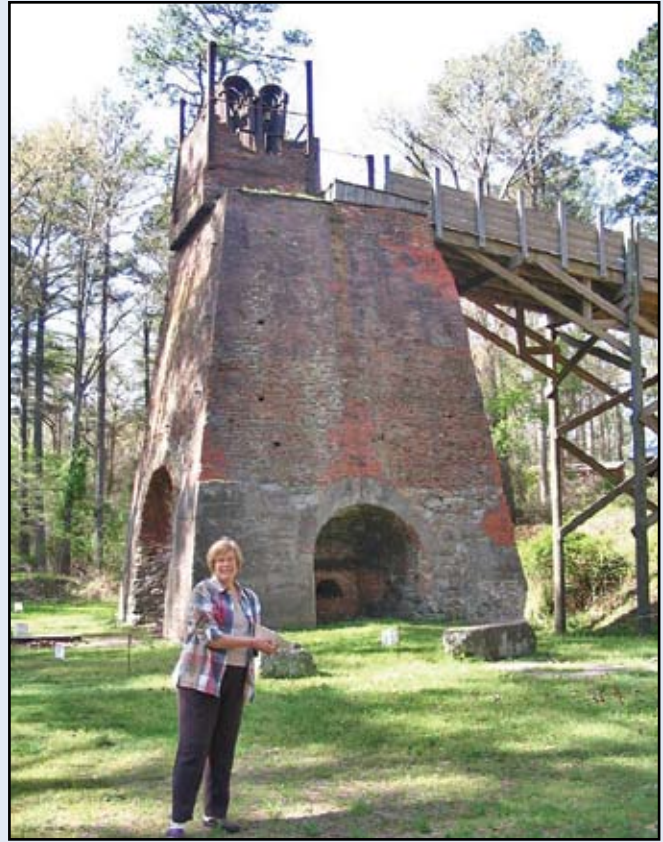


TRAVEL BACK IN TIME AT FURNACE TOWN

*Encounter the past and have an unforgettable experience at
Furnace Town, home of a National Historical Mechanical Engineering Landmark.*

Take in the sights and enjoy spectacular Eastern Shore vistas on this narrator-guided motorcoach tour from Ocean City to Furnace Town, an authentically reconstructed settlement that brings to life the daily activities of this 19th century village centered around Maryland's only bog iron smelting furnace. See artisans recreate the various crafts and professions that were part of Furnace Town. Proceed along the old stagecoach route to Snow Hill, chartered in 1686, and enjoy a box lunch along the wild and scenic Pocomoke River. Explore galleries, shops and The Purnell Museum - "The Attic of Worcester County."
